
All the retired teachers appreciated the national ranking of college. He asked suggestions for achieving NAAC score above 3.5 for the next NAAC cycle.



Introduction	
	Dr Nikunj Bhatt, Coordinator, IQAC, began the meeting by welcoming the dignitaries. Then Dr Bhatt in his address spelt out the objectives behind our efforts to sign MOUs with industries. He stressed on the fact that today's students need to stand out in the crowd and it is possible only they learn something that is beyond the syllabus. Dr Bhatt then invited the Principal Dr Bhavesh Patel for his presentation.
Presentation about the college	
	Dr Bhavesh Patel, Principal, first introduced the various faculty members to the dignitary. The dignitaries also introduced themselves. This was followed by a detailed presentation about the college and its research activities to enlighten the entrepreneurs about the kind of work the college is doing. The Principal was very categorical in his assertion that the intention behind the MOUs was purely academic and there is absolutely no liability on the companies to finance any project or to commit any jobs to students of the college. It was only to give industrial exposure to the students. The industry personnel can deliver guest talk in the college and also give inputs about the curricular inclusions/ changes and discuss the requires skill sets that need to be developed which would equip students to work in industries. If needed the professors can also impart some training to industries' new recruits. The Principal then requested the dignitaries to present their views.
	Here are the views expressed by the dignitaries :
i	Dr C P Patel, a former alumnus, a former professor and entrepreneur spoke about his days at the college and how he chose to become an entrepreneur, the challenges and how he overcame them. Dr Patel was very clear in his views that he would sign the MOU only after being fully convinced about the agreement. He was of the opinion that the academia and industry in more ways to improve the curriculum.
ii	Then Mr. Pradip Joshi, Group President and CEO of Green Circle, expressed his views. Mr. Joshi said about his company that among things, his company was mostly involved in Recovery Plants. He was of the opinion that it was a good idea to introduce Certificate courses for students in the field of Green Audit and the likes. He also welcomed interns from all science fields, especially from Micro biology, Industrial Chemistry and Physics, to his centre and there are opportunities for BSc Students in this field. There also is a good opportunity in collaborative R&D with the Academia. Mr. Joshi also expressed his interest in delivering talks.



	iii	Then, Dr. Tejas Shah of Usha Coatings, V U Nagar. Dr Shah informed all present that they manufacture paints. He was of the opinion that basic sciences are important because only they will help in proper understanding of the properties of materials and in future help in engineering new products/ material. Dr Shah offered in plant training to the college students and deliver special lectures in the college
	iv	Mr. Nitin Shah of Ravikiran Ceramics, Boriavi , informed about his company that they manufacture electrical ceramics and high tension insulators. Mr. Shah, an alumnus of the college welcomed fresh Chemistry and industrial graduates to work for the company.
	V	Mr. Ruchit Desai of Sahajahanad Beverages said there was good scope for students of Micro biology in his company for testing. He also wanted to know whether the college can produce minerals for beverages which they buy from the market.
	Vi	Mr. Dineshbhai Patel, Uma Plasto Tech., Khambat , manufacture PVC water tanks. He was of the opinion that the youth need education in entrepreneurship development and welcomed students for industrial visits anytime.
		Dr V K Sinha then briefed the dignitaries and the Heads of the depts.. about other companies like Swiss Glasscoat, Champion Paints, Nutan Ayurvedic, Global, Pharma and V M Chemicals are also willing to sign the MOUs with the college.
		Dr Charudutt Gurjar, Head English Dept. thanked all the visiting dignitaries and expressed the hope that this new association will provide valuable exposure to students and also be association of mutual benefits. He also reiterated what the Principal said that the companies have absolutely no financial or any other liability like job placements .

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


	At the outset the Principal welcomed everybody and began the meeting.

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



1	NAAC

2	ACTIVITIES
